The Cluster Energy consortium is pleased to present in a round table meeting with representatives of DG Energy, DG Regio and the Baltic Sea Region the results of the cluster energy pilot initiative and the potential funding sources to continue the cluster energy.

The presentation of the cluster challenge is combined with the main results of 8 projects to generate a new transnational value. It will promote the concept of a real network of corresponding projects and cluster partners to produce synergies.

**About the Cluster Energy**

The Monitoring Committee of the Baltic Sea Region Programme 2007-2013 initiated a new instrument for cooperation, the cluster initiatives. The objective of the cluster initiatives is to improve the Programme performance in regard to its relevance, effectiveness, and efficiency and to present the Programme outcomes to a broader public.

By increasing the awareness of the Programme's achievements, the results of the cluster initiatives shall also be taken into consideration for the future programming period 2014-2020.

The cluster "Energy efficiency and renewable energy sources" is the pilot cluster initiative. Eight projects and 16 partners from 6 countries represent the cluster energy financed by the Baltic Sea Region Programme 2007-2013.

The cluster energy contributes to protection of the climate and minimisation of fossil fuel consumption through using renewable energies and sustainable technologies, resource saving solutions in buildings and energy efficiency in the urban context. It focuses on power generation, buildings, cities, transport, mobility, planning, public involvement, co-operation and promotion. The aim is to develop a structure for an attractive eco-region to invest, to work and to live in.
